
## AFRICAN QUEEN

## (9 ½") BLOCK

- 1. 1(6 1/2") square for body
- 2. 1(2" x 3 ½") rectangle for head piece
- 3. 1(2") sq. for other part of head piece
- 4. 1(2") sq. for face
- 5. 2(1 1/2") sq. For hands, fold into triangle
- 6. 2(1 ½" x 3 ½") rectangle strips for sleeves
- 7. 2(1 1/2" x 3 1/2") rectangle strips under arms
- 8. 2(2 ½" x 6 ½") rectangle strips for background



## **AFRICAN QUEEN 91/2" BLOCK SEWING DIRECTIONS**

- Sew pieces #3and #4 together, which is the face and the smaller half of the head dress, and put aside.
- 2. Sew 2 sets of pieces #5, #6, #7 together, which are the sleeves, hands and underarm.
- 3. Sew piece #8 which is the background to #5, #6. #7 sewn together in step 2.
- 4. Sew piece #2, which is the larger half of head dress, to #3 and #4 sewn together in step 1, to complete head dress and face.
- 5. Sew one set of pieces #5. #6, #7, and #8 to the square made in step 4.
- 6. Sew one set of pieces sewn together in step 3 to piece #1.
- 7. Sew pieces sewn together in step 4 to pieces sewn together in step 6.
- 8. Square off block to measure 9 ½ inches.
